SUMMARY:

House Bill 1389 appropriates funding for the University of Pennsylvania. It would take effect July 1, 2015, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pennsylvania for the 2015-16 fiscal year. The appropriation for Veterinary Activities increases by \$840,000, or 3%, and the appropriation for the Center for Infectious Diseases increases by \$8,000, or 3%, over what was provided for the 2014-15 fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$29,109,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- for Veterinary Activities, \$28,840,000;
- for the Center for Infectious Diseases, \$269,000.
