SUMMARY: Amends the Vehicle Code to establish a historic military vehicle registration plate. This legislation would take effect in 120 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation allows owners of historic military vehicles to apply for and be issued special plates which have the same force and effect as antique or classic registration plates. A "historic military vehicle" is defined as an antique or classic vehicle, including a trailer, that was manufactured for use in any country's military forces and is maintained to represent the vehicle's military design and markings accurately.

The fee for the plate is \$75, and the applicant shall provide information as needed by PennDOT to satisfy the request that the vehicle is, in fact, a historic military vehicle.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, the total cost of this legislation would be approximately \$33,750 plus a production cost of \$3.50 per plate. These costs include \$31,250 for system changes and an additional \$2,500 for other changes including a license plate design fee, changes to forms, facts sheets and the website.

These costs could be absorbed within available funding. However, if PennDOT sells 473 plates at \$75 per plate in its first year, all costs would be covered.
