**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to delegate administration and enforcement of parking ordinances and resolutions to parking authorities in cities of the third class and second class A. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Section 6109 of the Vehicle Code to provide the following:

- Parking authorities of third class and second class A cities may enforce and administer ordinances and resolutions enacted or adopted by the city.
- These parking authorities will have jurisdiction over stopping, standing, and parking provisions in the Vehicle Code.
- By agreement with the third class or second class A city, parking authorities may transfer reasonable portions of fines, penalties, and costs collected to the city.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or political subdivision funds.
