SUMMARY: House Bill 1727, Printer's Number 2660, creates and adds two new decorations to the list of existing medals, badges, and awards that are authorized and presented by the Governor, in the name of the Commonwealth.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Chapter 37 of Title 51 (Military Affairs) to create and add two new decorations to the list of existing medals, badges, and awards that are authorized and presented by the Governor in the name of the Commonwealth: the Pennsylvania Achievement Medal and the Pennsylvania Veterans Service Award.

The bill also authorizes the additional recognition of civilians and veterans by the Governor to receive the Pennsylvania Medal of Achievement and the Pennsylvania Veterans Service Award.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
