**SUMMARY:** Increases the maximum cost of a copy of a police accident report from \$15 to \$22. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends section 3751 (relating to reports by police) of Title 75 to increase the maximum cost of a copy of a vehicle accident report that is furnished by a police department from \$15 to \$22.

If the request is made within 15 days of the accident, the police department must furnish an initial written report of the accident at the same time the report is delivered to PennDOT. If the initial report is not complete, a supplemental report must be submitted at a later date.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Municipalities would be able to realize additional revenues from the increased charge that would offset a larger portion of their cost to provide an accident report. Any estimate of that revenue or those costs is indeterminable at this point.
