SUMMARY: House Bill 1781, Printer's Number 3370, amends Title 53 to address and revise the membership of the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Section 2163 of Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) to change the membership of the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission, specifically by eliminating a Federal Bureau of Investigation special-agent-in-charge as a commission member and replacing it with one member of the Pennsylvania Lodge Fraternal Order of Police.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
