SUMMARY: Amends the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act to give graduate perfusionists the opportunity, if needed, to take their licensing examination more than once before their temporary graduate license is revoked. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act (Act 261 of 1978) to delete Section 13.3(h)(4) which will give graduate perfusionists the opportunity, if needed, to take their licensing examination more than once before their temporary graduate license is revoked.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
