SUMMARY: House Bill 1843, Printer's Number 2840, places the operation of the state's compulsive and problem gambling program under the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs (DDAP). This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Title 4 (Amusements) to place the operation of the state's compulsive and problem gambling program under DDAP. The program has been operated by DDAP since FY 2012-13 and the bill updates the statute to reflect this.

FISCAL IMPACT: The compulsive and problem gambling program is currently operated by DDAP, therefore, there is no fiscal impact related to passage of this legislation.
