SUMMARY: Amends the Cosmetology Law to clarify that cosmetology schools are permitted to charge the public a reasonable fee for student practice. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Cosmetology Law (Act 86 of 1933) to delete ambiguous language in Section 7 and to add language clearly stating that cosmetology schools may charge the public a reasonable fee, as approved by the Board, for the cosmetology services performed by students in their clinical training.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
