SUMMARY: Designates a portion of S.R. 309 in Lehigh County as the Officer David M. Petzold Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of State Route 309 between Passer Road and State Route 378 in Upper Saucon Township, Lehigh County as the Officer David M. Petzold Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
