**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 53 regarding the structure of a parking authority board in a city of the first class. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) Chapter 55 (Parking Authorities) to modernize the structure of the Philadelphia Parking Authority Board.

The legislation provides that the size of the Board shall remain at six members, but a majority (4 of the 6) must be residents of the city. All members of the Board must:

- be a resident of the city,
- work in the city, or
- maintain a business in the city.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Adoption of this amendment would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth, City of Philadelphia or Philadelphia Parking Authority funds.
