SUMMARY: Extends the validity of "in-transit" temporary registrations from 30 days to 60 days and allows PennDOT to assign monetary penalties in addition to the suspensions of an inspection station or mechanic for noncompliance. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends section 1310 of Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to allow a temporary registration card issued to a vehicle acquired in Pennsylvania for transportation to another state for registration or other use to be valid for 60 days. These temporary registration cards are currently only valid for 30 days.

Section 4724 of the Vehicle Code is amended to allow PennDOT to impose a monetary penalty on an inspection station which is found to be out of compliance with the law or PennDOT regulations. The schedule of all penalties, points, suspension may be established by PennDOT by publishing a notice in the PA Bulletin until final regulations are promulgated. Similarly, the legislation amends section 4726 to allow PennDOT to impose a monetary penalty in addition to a suspension if it is found that a mechanic has failed to comply with the law or PennDOT regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds
