SUMMARY:

House Bill 2082 amends the Public School Code concerning teacher professional education. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2082 provides that, if, during a professional educator's five-year continuing education compliance period, a teacher satisfactorily completes credits or hours in excess of the number of credits or hours required during that period, any excess credits or hours completed during the final two years of a professional educator's five-year compliance period must be credited to the educator's continuing professional education record for the next succeeding compliance period. A maximum of 50 hours of continuing professional education programs, activities or learning experiences, or any combination of collegiate studies, continuing professional education courses or other programs, activities or learning experiences equivalent to a maximum of 50 hours can be credited in this way.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
