SUMMARY:

House Bill 2138 appropriates funding for the University of Pittsburgh. It would take effect July 1, 2016, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pittsburgh for the 2016-17 fiscal year. The appropriation for General Support receives \$140,693,000 and Rural Education Outreach receives \$2,500,000. These are both the same amounts appropriated for 2015-16.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$143,193,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- for General Support, \$140,693,000;
- for Rural Education Outreach, \$2,500,000.
