SUMMARY:

House Bill 2141 appropriates funding for the University of Pennsylvania. It would take effect July 1, 2016, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pennsylvania for the 2016-17 fiscal year. The appropriation for Veterinary Activities receives \$29,400,000 and the appropriation for the Center for Infectious Diseases receives \$274,000. Both are the same amounts that were provided for in the 2015-16 fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$29,674,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- for Veterinary Activities, \$29,400,000;
- for the Center for Infectious Diseases, \$274,000.
