#### SUMMARY:

House Bill 2153 amends the Judicial Code concerning delinquent acts. It would take effect in 60 days.

#### ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2153 adds language to the definition of "Delinquent act" in the Judicial Code. This language provides that the failure of a child to comply with a lawful sentence imposed for a summary offense constitutes a delinquent act. This clarification ensures that the juvenile courts retain jurisdiction over enforcement of such cases.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
