**SUMMARY:** Amends Title 8 (Boroughs and Incorporated Towns) to establish emergency procurement procedures. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Chapter 14 (Contracts) of Title 8 to allow a borough to make contracts or purchases without requiring advertising, bidding or price quotations in situations deemed emergencies. Councils will be required to state in a resolution at the next public meeting, the actual emergency and the nature of the procurement.

The legislation also adds a cross reference to Title 35 (Health and Safety), which allows municipalities to make emergency purchases.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or borough funds.
