SUMMARY:

House Bill 2241 amends Title 40 (Insurance) concerning retroactive denial of reimbursements. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2241 adds a new chapter to Title 40 (Insurance) concerning retroactive denial of reimbursements. The chapter prohibits an insurer from retroactively denying reimbursement more than 24 months after the date the insurer initially paid the healthcare provider. It also requires an insurer that retroactively denies reimbursement to a health care provider to give the health care provider a written statement specifying the basis for the denial. Exceptions to the 24-month limitation are also provided for in the legislation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
