SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 130 amends the Judicial Code concerning sentences for community service. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation adds a new section, "Sentence of community service," to the Judicial Code. It states that a person sentenced to a term of supervised community service or required by a court or a paroling authority to participate in a public or nonprofit community service program may not purchase credit in lieu of performing the community service in any form. This would include United States or foreign currency, a money order, a check, a prepaid debit or credit card, a gift card or certificate, or any other means of remuneration.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
