SUMMARY: Authorizes the conveyance of two permanent utility and access easements in Peter's Township, Franklin County.

ANALYSIS: SB 266 authorizes the Department of General Services, with the approval of the PA Historical and Museum Commission, to grant and convey two permanent utility and access easements to the Bear Valley Franklin County Pennsylvania Joint Authority at the Fort Loudon Historical Site in Peter's Township, Franklin County. The parcels (approximately 3.515-acres and 2.525-acres, respectively) are for purposes of groundwater withdrawal for a one-time payment of \$19,500.

Effective Date: Immediately

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. The proceeds from the easement agreement, \$19,500, shall be deposited in the General Fund.
