SUMMARY: Amends the Vehicle Code to redesign driver's license and identification card applications regarding the organ donor designation. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 8619 of the Vehicle Code (relating to use of driver's license or identification card to indicate organ or tissue donation) to include the following statement and question on both the application for a driver's license or identification card and on the organ donor designation at a photo center:

"Pennsylvania strongly supports organ and tissue donation because of its life-saving and life-enhancing opportunities. Do you wish to have the organ donor designation printed on your driver's license?"

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, the software changes and updating of departmental forms would cost the department approximately \$45,000. That cost could be absorbed within currently allocated funds.
