**SUMMARY:** Authorizes the release of Project 70 restrictions on land located in North Middleton Township, Cumberland County. This legislation would take effect immediately.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation allows certain lands owned by the Borough of Carlisle, within North Middleton Township, Cumberland County, which contain a right-of-way along the Pennsylvania Turnpike, to be released from Project 70 restrictions and conveyed in exchange for the development of park and open-space lands. The funds that are received from the sale of the land shall be for the development of park and open-space lands owned by the Borough of Carlisle as approved by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. Any funds that are not spent after 5 years shall be paid to the Commonwealth for deposit into the Project 70 Land Acquisition Sinking Fund or current equivalent.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
