SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 678 amends the Public School Code concerning the State System of Higher Education. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 678 amends the definition of "grounds" within the Public School Article concerning the State System of Higher Education. It adds that all highways, trafficways and bicycle and pedestrian facilities that traverse or abut all lands and buildings owned, controlled, leased or managed by the State System of Higher Education fit within the definition. This has the practical effect of expanding the jurisdiction of State System campus police to areas immediately surrounding the campuses of the State System of Higher Education.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
