SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 913 appropriates funding for the University of Pennsylvania. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pennsylvania for the 2015-16 fiscal year. The appropriation for Veterinary Activities increases by \$1.4 million, or 5%, and the appropriation for the Center for Infectious Diseases increases by \$13,000, or 5%, over what was provided for the 2014-15 fiscal year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$29,674,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- for Veterinary Activities, \$29,400,000;
- for the Center for Infectious Diseases, \$274,000.
