SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 915 appropriates funding for the University of Pittsburgh. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the University of Pittsburgh for the 2015-16 fiscal year. The appropriation for General Support receives a 5% increase of \$6,700,000 and Rural Education Outreach receives a 9% increase of \$200,000 over amounts appropriated for 2014-15.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$143,193,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- for General Support, \$140,693,000;
- for Rural Education Outreach, \$2,500,000.
