SUMMARY: Makes two designations in Westmoreland County. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 1017, over Mill Creek in Ligonier Township, Westmoreland County as the Lieutenant Eric Eslary Memorial Bridge. The legislation also designates a portion of S.R. 981 in Westmoreland County as the James Paul Takitch Honorary Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, intersection or walkway costs \$500. Since there are 2 designations within the legislation, the total cost is \$1,000. That cost can be absorbed within currently allocated funds.
