SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 1038 amends Act 293 of 1921 concerning Juvenile Detention Boards in third class counties. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Under current law, the juvenile detention governing board in third class counties consists of the County Commissioners, the Sheriff, and the County Controller. Senate Bill 1038 adds the President Judge of the Court of Common Pleas to that board. The position can be delegated by the President Judge to any other Judge serving under the President Judge. The position can also be deleted by the President Judge and reinstated by any future President Judge.

This legislation also updates Act 293 to reflect current language as used in the Juvenile Act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
