SUMMARY: Designates a portion of S.R. 523 in Somerset County as the Private First Class Nils G. Thompson Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of S.R. 523, also known as Listonburg Road, in Somerset County, from the northbound intersection of U.S. Route 40 to southbound mile marker 110, as the Private First Class Nils G. Thompson Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to traffic in both directions on the highway.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, intersection or walkway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
