**SUMMARY:** Designates Exit 18 of S.R. 43 in Fayette County as the Staff Sgt. John P. Wanto Vietnam Veteran Exit. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation designates Exit 18 of S.R. 43, known as the Searights Road Interchange, in Fayette County as the Staff Sgt. John P. Wanto Vietnam Veteran Exit.

Staff Sergeant John P. Wanto served with the U.S. Army, A Company, First Battalion, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division. He was killed in action on March 21, 1970 in the Thua Thien Province of Vietnam.

The PA Turnpike Commission shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic on the highway near the exit.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to the Turnpike Commission, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, or exit costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed within existing funds.
