SUMMARY: Designates Exit 15 of S.R. 43 in Fayette County as the Lance Corporal Russell W. Naugle Vietnam Veteran Exit. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates Exit 15 of S.R. 43, known as the Old Pittsburgh Road interchange, in Fayette County as the Lance Corporal Russell W. Naugle Vietnam Veteran Exit.

Lance Corporal Russell W. Naugle served with the U.S. Marine Corps, C Company, First Battalion, First Marine Division, III Marine Amphibious Force. He was killed in action on February 15, 1968 in the Quang Nam Province of Vietnam.

The PA Turnpike Commission shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: Typically, the installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
