**SUMMARY:** Amends the PA Construction Code Act to give the Department of Labor & Industry (L&I) the authority to contract with the International Codes Council (ICC) to: 1) create a PA-specific set of code books; and 2) require that such code books be available online in "read only" format to the general public. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Section 304 ("Revised or Successor Codes") of the PA Construction Code Act to state that L&I may contract with the ICC to establish a set of code books that represent the specific requirements of the Uniform Construction Code (UCC).

The legislation requires that, if L&I enters into such a contract with the ICC, such code books must be made available online to the general public.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
