**SUMMARY:** Designates a portion of S.R. 562 in Berks County as the General Carl A. Spaatz Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation designates a portion of S.R. 562 in Berks County, from the intersection with S.R. 73 in the Borough of Boyertown to the intersection with S.R. 662 at the township line between Amity Township and Oley Township, as the General Carl A. Spaatz Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
