SUMMARY:

House Bill 561 amends Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) relating to administrative subpoenas.

ANALYSIS:

HB 561 amends the Crimes Code by repealing the sunset provision in Section 5743.1 (f) (Expiration), relating to the issuance of administrative subpoenas in an investigation involving child sexual exploitation or abuse.

This legislation will take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
