SUMMARY:

House Bill 594, Printer's Number 626 amends Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) by prohibiting Accelerated Rehabilitation Disposition (ARD) for certain offenses against children.

ANALYSIS:

HB 594 amends the Crimes Code by adding a new Section 1111 to prohibit the recommendation and court authorization of ARD for an individual charged with rape, involuntary deviate sexual intercourse and aggravated indecent assault when a victim of these crimes is under the age of 18.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
