SUMMARY: House Bill 760, Printer's Number 861, designates September 27th of each year as "First Responders Day" in Pennsylvania.

ANALYSIS: This bill establishes the First Responders Day Act, which designates September 27th of each year as "First Responders Day" in Pennsylvania to honor police, fire, emergency medical service, and public health personnel.

The Governor shall issue an annual proclamation calling upon all public schools and educational institutions to observe "First Responders Day" and to conduct exercises recognizing the contributions and remembering sacrifices that first responders have made. The bill specifies that "First Responders Day" may not be a paid holiday or a day that the school districts close.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
