SUMMARY:

House Bill 782, Printer's Number 1680, amends Title 4 (Amusements) further providing for definitions and nongaming service providers.

ANALYSIS:

The legislation amends Section 1103 (Definitions) by adding new definitions of "Gaming floor," "Gaming-related restricted area" and "Nongaming service provider." Changes are made to the definition of "Gaming service provider" by incorporating the newly defined terms.

New Section 1317.3 (Nongaming service provider) outlines and expedites the notification/permitting process for slot machine licensees or applicants to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (PGCB) when the slot machine licensee or applicant contracts or does business with a nongaming service provider. The legislation outlines the notification requirements, contents of notification, duration of notification, conditions, PGCB authority to exempt, additional authority to PGCB, emergency notifications, nongaming service provider lists and duties of nongaming service providers.

This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
