SUMMARY:

House Bill 1008 amends Title 23 (Domestic Relations) further providing for persons qualified to solemnize marriages.

ANALYSIS:

HB 1008 repeals Section 1303 (Waiting period after application), removing the three-day waiting period for marriage license issuance. Section 1307 (Issuance of license) is amended by allowing for the immediate issuance of a marriage license following the submission of a properly completed application. Lastly, Section 1503 (Persons qualified to solemnize marriages) is amended to permit former mayors, former or retired justices, judges or magisterial district judges of this Commonwealth to solemnize marriages.

This legislation would be effective 60 days after enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
