SUMMARY: Designates the bridge on S.R. 125 in Schuylkill County as the Abner Yoder Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the bridge on S.R. 125, before Ridge Road in Pitman, Schuylkill County as the Abner Yoder Memorial Bridge.

Abner Yoder joined the U.S. Army Air Corps and rose to the level of Technical Sergeant in 1943. On February 17, 1944, his plane had engine troubles and attempted to return to base but stalled and crashed. The entire crew was lost in the plane crash.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
