SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of U.S. Route 11 over the Susquehanna River in Luzerne County as the Specialist Dale J. Kridlo Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of U.S. Route 11 over the Susquehanna River between the city of Pittston and West Pittston Borough in Luzerne County as the Specialist Dale J. Kridlo Memorial Bridge.

At just 33 years of age, Specialist Kridlo made the ultimate sacrifice for his country when he was killed in Kunar Province, Afghanistan on November 7, 2010, while serving in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
