SUMMARY: Designates a bridge at the junction of S.R. 150 and S.R. 64 in Clinton County as the U.S. Navy SOC David M. Collins Veterans Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge at the junction of S.R. 150 and S.R. 64 over Fishing Creek in Mill Hall Borough in Clinton County as the U.S. Navy SOC David M. Collins Veterans Memorial Bridge.

Chief Petty Officer Collins completed deployments to South America, Iraq and Afghanistan and served in the first Gulf War, the Iraq War and Operation Enduring Freedom. His awards and decorations include a Bronze Star Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal with Valor, Army Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Combat Action Ribbon, eight Navy Good Conduct Medals and numerous service and campaign awards.

Chief Petty Officer Collins retired in September 2012 from the U.S. Navy after 25 years of service.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
