SUMMARY: Designates a highways and two bridges in Franklin County. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes the following highway/bridge designations:

- The section of S.R. 1001, from Memorial Road to Mt. Pleasant Road in Greene Township, Franklin County as the Lance Corporal Michael L. Freeman, Jr., Memorial Highway.
- The bridge located on S.R. 533 over Muddy Run in Southampton Township, Franklin County as the Private First Class Dana Edward Diehl Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge on S.R. 1004 over the Conococheague Creek in Greene Township, Franklin County as the Private Charles W. "Bill" Roher Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. Since there are three designations within this legislation, the cost would total \$1,500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
