SUMMARY: Designates a portion of S.R. 18 in Crawford County as the Staff Sergeant James Douglas Mowris Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of S.R. 18 in West Fallowfield Township in Crawford County, from the intersection with S.R. 322 to the Crawford/Mercer County line, as the Staff Sergeant James Douglas Mowris Memorial Highway.

For nearly 20 years, Staff Sergeant Mowris honorably served his country on active duty with the U.S. Army and with the Army Reserve.

Staff Sergeant Mowris was killed in action on January 29, 2004, along with seven other soldiers, from an explosion during the clearing of an enemy weapons and ammunition cache in Ghazni, Afghanistan.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
