SUMMARY: Amends the Barbers' License Law to allow barbers to practice outside of a licensed barber shop provided they accept no compensation for that work. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Barbers' License Law (Act 202 of 1931) to change the definition of "Barbering" to specify that the definition only includes the listed services when they are performed for compensation.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
