SUMMARY: House Bill 1527, Printer's Number 2913, amends Title 23 (Domestic Relations) to update the mandated reporting provisions in Chapter 63, Child Protective Services. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Child Protective Services to explicitly state that a mandated reporter shall report suspected child abuse if he or she witnesses an act of child abuse against an identifiable child whenever and wherever the mandated reporter witnesses such an act.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no anticipated fiscal impact related to passage of this legislation. The legislation expressly clarifies language that mandated reporters must report suspected child abuse if they witness such an act.
