SUMMARY: House Bill 1588, Printer's Number 2188, amends the Pharmaceutical Assistance for the Elderly under the State Lottery Law regarding death verification of individuals enrolled in the PACE and PACENET program. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation requires the Department of Aging to establish a process to cross-reference those individuals enrolled in the PACE and PACENET program, at least once per month, against the Department of Health death records information. If a death record is found for an enrollee, immediate cancellation of benefits shall occur.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to the Department of Aging, enactment of this legislation to establish monthly cross-checks of PACE and PACENET enrollees against the Department of Health's death records will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
