**SUMMARY:** Designates multiple bridges/highways across the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation makes the following traffic designations:

- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 1008 over the Codorus Creek in East Manchester Township and Hellam Township, York County, as the SPC Martin Wilson Kondor Memorial Bridge.
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 119 in Indiana County as the PFC Frank Enzer Weiss United States Marine Corps Bridge.
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 125 in Schuylkill County as the Abner Yoder Memorial Bridge.
- A portion of S.R. 562 in Berks County as the General Carl A. Spaatz Memorial Bridge.
- A portion of Interstate 176 in Berks County as the Vietnam War Veterans Memorial Highway.
- A portion of Interstate 176 in Berks County as the Persian Gulf War Veterans Memorial Highway.
- A portion of Interstate 176 in Berks County as the Iraq and Afghanistan War Veterans Memorial Highway.
- A portion of S.R. 611 in Monroe County as the Roy G. Gross, Sr. Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. Since there are eight traffic designations, the total cost would be \$4,000. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
