SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 1005 in Philadelphia County as the Officer Gary Frank Skerski Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 1005, also known as Castor Avenue over Frankford Creek in the City of Philadelphia, in Philadelphia County as the Officer Gary Frank Skerski Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
