SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 2026 in Indiana County as the First Lieutenant Theodore P. Pytash Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 2026, over the North Branch Blacklick Creek in Buffington Township, Indiana County as the First Lieutenant Theodore P. Pytash Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
