**SUMMARY**: Eliminates the \$2 and \$6 fees associated with ordering a duplicate vehicle registration card, when that vehicle registration card is printed by the applicant. This legislation would take effect in 90 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation exempts those motorists who wish to print duplicate copies of their vehicle registration from having to pay the additional \$2 and \$6 fees established in Title 75 §1932 (related to duplicate registration cards) This exemption does not apply to duplicate registration cards processed by PennDOT or an agent service of PennDOT in an over-the-counter transaction or by mail.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds as there is no revenue being generated when an individual prints duplicate copies of their vehicle registration at home.
