SUMMARY: Designates a portion of SR 2022 in Montgomery County as the SPC5 George W. Charters, Jr., Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of SR 2022, known as Fort Washington Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County as the SPC5 George W. Charters, Jr., Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
